Explorers (0-1 years)

Over the past few months we have been looking at the following topics: Nursery rhymes, the weather, transport and minibeasts. We are currently looking at my body.

For nursery rhymes we took the babies to the local library to collect some new books regarding this topic. We sang favorite nursery rhymes to them and we also got messy with the paints to make a wall display.

Nursery Rhymes



Discoverers (1-2 years)

Over the last few weeks we have been learning all about farm animals, zoo animals, transport, minibeasts & peek a boo in the ocean.

The children were very interested in one of our story books called peek- a - boo in the ocean so we decided to take this further and do on a topic on this

We visited our local library and made a wall display.

We then moved onto farm animals where the children learned the noises that the animals make by playing with the puppets and signing songs. The children also made a display by painting the animals and a barn.

Over the next few weeks we will be learning about nursery rhymes and Easter.

Investigators (2-3 years)

In the 2-3-year-old room the children have been learning all about transport, my body, healthy eating and will be moving onto mother's day. We also celebrated world book day.

Currently we are focusing on unhealthy eating. Looking at this topic healthy and unhealthy, the children enjoyed a trip to the library where we borrowed books to help gain an understanding of the importance of a healthy, balanced diet, the children also changed the role play area into a shop. We also did lots of messy play relating to the topic such as fruit and veg printing, scented playdough ect.



Inventors (3-5 years)

In the pre-school room we have been looking at the topics: 5 senses, animals, space and are currently looking at the weather/seasons.

For the topic space we learned about the solar system, we created a space wall display with aliens and spaceships, we also collected new books on this topic from our local library.

We then moved onto animals, we learned about all the different types of animals. We talked about where we would see animals. We also had to draw a picture of our favorite animal and what sound this made.

We are currently looking at the topic weather, for this topic we are learning about the four seasons, we have done a wall display, cutting and gluing sheets where we had to match the pictures with the correct season.

We also had fun playing in the garden, playing games.
